Ana Pinto Martinho is the editor of the European Journalism Observatory (EJO) in Portuguese and a guest lecturer at ISCTE-IUL. She is also a researcher at OberCom – Observatório da Comunicação and a research assistant at CIES-IUL.

She is involved in several European research projects such as Newsreel, CoMMPASS, AMAZE, IBERIFIER, and Algowatch, and is part of the Portuguese team working on the Digital News Report from the Reuters Institute for the Study of Journalism at the University of Oxford. She participates in EJO network studies, including research on European media coverage of migration issues.

As a journalist, she led the iGOV project, a media outlet dedicated to public administration, government, eGovernment, open data, and citizenship. Her work in the open data field includes collaboration on the first Open Data Manual by the Agency for Administrative Modernization (AMA). She was also a journalist for the Portuguese edition of InformationWeek, director of the publication Interface – Administração Pública, and worked for media outlets such as Diário de Notícias, Semanário Sol, and RTP Informação.
