Since January 1, 2019, she has been serving as the Director of Energy Planning and Statistics Services at the Direção-Geral de Energia e Geologia (DGEG), where she is responsible for coordinating, monitoring, and overseeing the implementation of numerous public policy instruments in the energy sector, notably the preparation, review, and monitoring of the National Energy and Climate Plan.

She is the Vice-President of the Energy Emergency Planning Commission, a member of the Advisory Council of ERSE and the Higher Statistics Council, and a national delegate in various Committees and Working Groups of the European Commission, the International Energy Agency, NATO, and other international organizations in the areas of statistics, energy and climate, energy planning, supply security, infrastructure, and emergency response in the energy sector (electricity, gas, and oil). She has participated, at the invitation of the International Energy Agency, as an expert in several reviews of energy policies and emergency responses of member countries.

She served as Head of the Energy Planning and Supply Security Division (2013-2018) and Head of the Fuel Licensing and Inspection Division (2007-2013) at DGEG. She has been a senior technician at DGEG since 1994, providing advisory services to the Directorate and working in the areas of electric energy, renewable energies, and energy efficiency until 2007.

She also worked at the former Direção Geral do Ambiente (1992-1993) and at the Instituto Superior de Engenharia de Lisboa (1990-1994).
